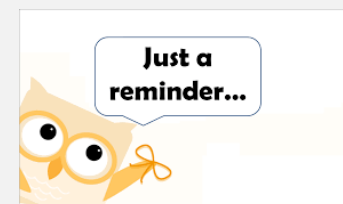
COOKING UP A STORM!
